**Tax Statements** 

Parents can download statements as needed through LineLeader. To access statements...

**log in on a web browser (not on the app)...** From the dashboard, click view and pay. Click the "Payment Statement" icon. Then select Custom Range to select the dates you need. Then **select Detail** and Generate Report. From there, you'll be able to download the report. This option is only available when there is a current balance due. New invoices are created each Friday and auto pay is applied on Monday. So, Fridays are the best day to create statements.
